

1) **Numbers 6:22-26**

וַיְדַבֵּר יְהוָה אֶל־מֹשֶׁה לֵאמֹר:

The LORD spoke to Moses:

דַּבֵּר אֶל־אַהֲרֹן וְאֶל־בָּנָיו לֵאמֹר כֹּה תְבַרְכוּ אֶת־בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל אָמֹר לָהֶם

Speak to Aaron and his sons: Thus shall you bless the people of Israel. Say to them:

בְּרַכְכֶם יְהוָה וַיִּשְׁמְרֶךָ

The LORD bless you and protect you!

יֵאָר יְהוָה | פָּגְיוֹ אֵלֶיךָ וַיַּחַמְדֶּךָ:

The LORD deal kindly and graciously with you!

(Sifri: Grant you charm in the eyes of everyone)

יֵשָׂא יְהוָה | פָּגְיוֹ אֵלֶיךָ וַיַּשֵּׁם לָךְ שְׁלוֹמִים:

The LORD bestow His favor upon you and grant you peace!

2) **Proverbs 31:30**: יָשָׁר דַּעַן וְהַבֵּל הַיָּפִי אֵשֶׁה יִרְאֵת־יְהוָה הִיא תִתְהַלָּל:

Grace is deceptive, Beauty is illusory; It is for her fear of the LORD That a woman is to be praised.

3) **Esther 2: 15**

וּבְהִגִּיעַ תֵּרֶם־אֶסְתֵּר בַּת־אַבְיָתָר יָד מֶרְדֵּכָי אֲשֶׁר לָקַח־לָּוּ לְבַת לְבוּא אֶל־הַמֶּלֶךְ לֹא בִקְשָׁה דָבָר כִּי אִם אֶת־אֲשֶׁר־יֹאמַר הַגִּי סְרִיס־הַמֶּלֶךְ שִׁמְרֵם הַנְּשִׂימִים וַתְּהִי אֶסְתֵּר נִשְׂאֵת חֹן בְּעֵינֵי כָל־רֵאִיָּה:

When the turn came for Esther daughter of Abihail—the uncle of Mordecai, who had adopted her as his own daughter—to go to the king, she did not ask for anything but what Hegai, the king’s eunuch, guardian of the women, advised. **Yet Esther won the admiration of all who saw her.** (Also see Genesis 39: 21)

4) **Babylonian Talmud Sotah 47 a**

אמר רבי יוחנן שלשה חינות הן חן מקום על יושביו חן אשה על בעלה חן מקח על מקחו

Rabbi Yoḥanan says: There are three graces that have a similar impact: The grace of a place upon its inhabitants; the grace of a woman upon her husband; and the grace of a purchased item upon the one who has purchased it.

5) **New Testament - Ephesians 2:8-9**

For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it* is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
