Hosea 14:2-10

(2) Return, O Israel, to the LORD your God,
For you have fallen because of your sin. (3)
Take words with you
And return to the LORD.
Say to Him:
“Forgive all guilt
And accept what is good;
Instead of bulls we will pay
[The offering of] our lips. (4) Assyria shall
not save us,
No more will we ride on steeds;
Nor ever again will we call
Our handiwork our god,
Since in You alone orphans find pity!” (5) I
will heal their affliction,
Generously will I take them back in love;
For My anger has turned away from them.
(6) I will be to Israel like dew;
He shall blossom like the lily,
He shall strike root like a Lebanon tree. (7)
His boughs shall spread out far,
His beauty shall be like the olive tree’s,
His fragrance like that of Lebanon. (8) They
who sit in his shade shall be revived:
They shall bring to life new grain,
They shall blossom like the vine;
